Project Description

Cleveland Bridge UK Limited in partnership with CI Sarantopoulos S.A. were awarded the contract for the supply of the deck steelwork for the 2,252 m bridge, which will be the longest cable stayed structure in the World and the longest bridge in Greece, will span the Gulf of Corinth at Patras and provide a permanent link between the Peloponnese and the western mainland of Greece.

Fabrication of the 17,000 tonnes of steelwork will take place at Cleveland's facility in Darlington between February 2002 and September 2003.

Cleveland were also awarded the contract to assemble the steelwork on site. The assembly work will be undertaken from November 2002 through until July 2004 and will be carried out in conjunction with Greek subcontractor, Metka. The bridge is due to open in time for the 2004 Olympic Games.
